It is very important to us to protect your personal data in compliance with the German Federal Data Protection Act and the ISO DIN 9001/2000 Standard.

Below, please find information as to which data will be recorded during your visit to our website and how this data will be utilized.

The security of your personal data

Any access to our websites and any access to the data stored on the site will be logged. This information is saved for in-house system-related and statistical purposes. The following will be logged: the name of the file accessed, the date and time the access occurred, the transferred data volume, notification as to whether the access was successful, the web browser used and the requesting domain. Moreover, the IP addresses of the requesting computers will be logged.

Any additional personal data will be saved by us only if you enter them into a form at your own discretion. You will do this in conjunction with an inquiry, a registration or application to participate in an event.

In a few cases you will have to use session dependent cookies on our websites. However, the former do not include any personal data and will be deleted automatically at the latest when your browser is closed.

Our actual data processing occurs in the DSC Software AG network, which is protected by firewalls and anti-virus programs.

We take all necessary technical and organizational precautions to protect your personal data against loss and abuse. If you are communicating with us via e-mail, however, we cannot completely warrant the security of your data; hence we recommend you opt to correspond with us through the postal service when sharing confidential information.

4. Purpose of data generation, processing and utilization

6. Recipients of data

Recipients who may be sent said data upon request:

- External contacts and partners who are involved in the business processes stipulated under 4
- Banking and financial institutions who process payment transactions within the scope of the business processed stipulated under 4
- Public organizations that have to receive data in compliance with statutory requirements, e.g. government agencies and social security insurance providers

7. Mandatory data deletion deadlines

The data shall be deleted upon expiration of the archiving periods mandated by applicable laws or by the competent supervisory agencies. Data not subject to such mandatory archiving periods shall be deleted once the purpose they are tied to no longer exists.

Data transfers to third countries are not being made and do not occur.
